

# Electronic Giving

Electronic Giving is a program for our members, providing you the opportunity to sign up to have your offering conveniently transferred from your credit card, checking or savings account into the church's bank account every month.

Today, many of us already are willing to have money transferred from our bank accounts to pay utility bills, mortgages, fitness memberships and more. The reasons are convenience and the certainty that a payment won't be skipped. For these same reasons, the Electronic Giving Program benefits those who want to faithfully and consistently provide their offerings to the church.



Additionally, by signing up for Electronic Giving, the Church Council is better able to predict congregational giving and make more informed decisions when setting budgets and funding special projects, like the Chapel and Organ repairs.

## How does Electronic Giving work?

Two types of Electronic Giving are available, one-time and recurring offerings.

A one-time offering is simple to make. Simply select the fund(s) to which you want to contribute, the amount of the offering, and provide your payment information.

To set up a recurring offering, you'll need to create a user account. Once you do that, you can choose the fund(s) to which you want to contribute, the amount, the frequency, and the day of the week or month on which those offerings should be made.

Offerings can be made using a checking or savings account, or your credit card, and can be changed at any time.

Still want to put something in the offering plate when you attend church? Simply bring your envelope and write "Electronic Giving" instead of an amount. No need to remember cash or a check book.

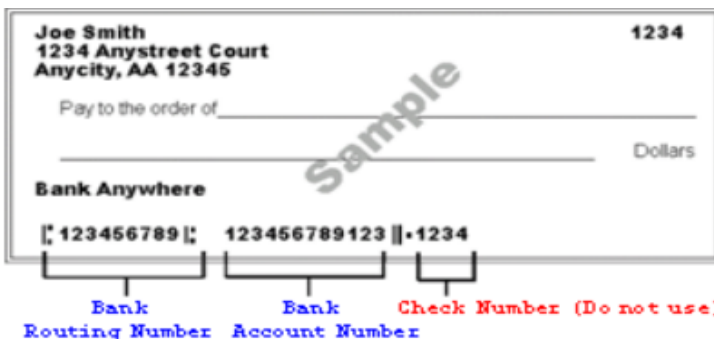
